PRIVACY POLICY

Some information provided to us might be considered to be personal. We will only collect such personal information if it is necessary for one of our functions or activities. Personal information about visitors to our site is collected only when knowingly and voluntarily submitted.

For example, we may collect information to answer or forward any requests or enquiries, or provide you with further services. It is our intention that this policy will protect your personal information from being handled in a way that is inconsistent with applicable privacy laws in Australia.

Unless we disclose other uses in this Privacy Policy or at the time of collection, we will only use personal information that is submitted to us or through our website for the purpose or purposes for which it is submitted, or for such other secondary purposes that are related to the primary purpose.

To enable you to take full advantage of our services, we may collect personal information about you including your name, email address, address, telephone numbers and the option to receive updates and promotional material and other information. You can unsubscribe from any marketing initiatives at any time.

We reserve the right to engage third parties on occasion in order that we may provide you with goods or services on our behalf. In such circumstances, we may disclose your personal information to those third parties in order to meet your request for goods or services.

Security measures are reviewed and updated in light of current technologies and, to the best of our efforts, we strive to ensure the security, integrity and privacy of personal information submitted. No data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be totally secure, however we will endeavour to take all reasonable steps to protect personal information.

We also work to keep such information accurate and up to date. If, at any time, you discover that information held about you is incorrect, you may contact us to have the information corrected.

Apart from where you have consented, or disclosure is necessary to achieve the purpose for which information or data was submitted, we may disclose personal information in special situations where we have reason to believe that doing so is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against anyone damaging, injuring, or interfering (intentionally or unintentionally) our rights or property, users, or anyone else who could be harmed by such activities. Also, we may disclose personal information when we believe in good faith that the law requires disclosure.

Our staff and the contractors who provide services related to our information systems are obliged to care for and respect the confidentiality of any personal information held by us. However, we will not be held responsible for events arising from unauthorised access to your personal information.
